accident and a commercial crash case, respectively. Robert and firm partner David Cain obtained a \$779,477.00 jury verdict for a mechanic who was injured on the job. This outcome is particularly remarkable given that the defendant had only offered one dollar (\$1.00) prior to the verdict.

- \$1.0M settlement for injuries caused by improperly maintained utility truck.
- \$900k settlement for injuries sustained in a crash caused by logging truck.
- \$1.1M settlement for injuries to bicyclist.
- \$650k settlement for injuries in crash caused by commercial vehicle.
- \$6.0M settlement for injuries in a crash caused by a heavy commercial truck.
