Jenna practices in the areas of automobile and trucking accidents, premises liability, products liability, industrial accidents, medical malpractice, and fraud. Since starting her practice in 2019, Jenna has tried multiple cases that resulted in cumulative awards of over \$2.6 million and recovered over \$5.5 million in confidential settlements for her clients.

A few of Jenna's case results as lead and co-counsel include:

- \$650,000 jury verdict for pedestrian who suffered a broken arm after being hit by a dump truck
- \$577,301 jury verdict for a woman injured at Walmart
- \$500,000 jury verdict for a woman injured when an 18-wheeler backed into her car
- \$482,000 jury verdict for a woman injured in a motor vehicle collision
- \$450,000 jury verdict for a man who suffered a sternal fracture in a car crash
- \$426,300 jury verdict for a rear end collision
